Dr. Jones called the meeting to order. The minutes from the November 17, 2011 meeting were distributed and approved as written.

New Business:

Chris D’Esposito presented an overview of the parking changes and projects planned for the future.

1. Presidential Village residential community phase I, formerly called North Bluff, is scheduled to open in August.
2. Rose Towers will be razed later this year. Construction on Presidential Village residential community phase II will begin on this site.
3. A new 750 space parking deck will be constructed south of The Highlands.
4. An expansion is planned for the Ferguson Student Center which may impact the South Ferguson reserved parking lot.
5. The Science and Engineering Complex reserved parking lot is now open.
6. The new indoor tennis facility is now open.
7. A new 750 space commuter parking lot will be constructed east of the Child Development Research Center.
8. Perimeter parking will be removed from the Child Development Research Center.
9. Construction has begun on four new sorority houses that will be located south of New Magnolia Drive.
10. The SGA has requested that Parking Services consider installing timed parking in various areas on campus. Parking Services has contacted several vendors to obtain information.
