

Parking and Traffic Regulations Committee Meeting
November 14, 2012

Dr. Jones called the meeting. The minutes from the October 17, 2012 meeting were distributed and approved as written.

New Business:

- **Alex Masenheimer was invited to speak to the committee concerning skateboarding on campus. He was unable to attend the meeting today but Dr. Jones will notify him when the January meeting date has been scheduled.**
- **Chris D'Esposito asked the committee for their feedback concerning the Parking Services wait lists policy for reserve parking decks and lots. He stated that when an opening occurs in a previously sold out deck or lot, Parking Services uses the established wait list for that area to fill the vacancy. If that individual declines the opportunity to move into their desired area, they remain in their current position on the wait list.**

After a brief discussion, a motion was made to recommend that Parking Services revise their wait lists policy to state that when a vacancy occurs in a reserve lot or deck, the established numerical wait list will be used to fill the vacancy. If an individual declines the vacancy, their name will be removed from the wait list and they may reapply. A vote was held and the motion passed unanimously.

Old Business:

- **At the October 17, 2012 meeting, Erica Luby stated that the crosswalk leading from Coleman Coliseum to Bryant Conference Center was not being observed and it was difficult to see at night.**

Chris has contacted the City of Tuscaloosa and pedestrian signage will be installed within the next few days.

Dr. Reuben Cook distributed a list of issues from employees within his department that were discussed by the committee. Several of the items addressed the need for enforcement when bicyclist and skate boarders violate the rules. Another area of concern was the number of state vehicles parking in the designated bicycle lanes. Dr. Jones will address these issues in a memo to Dr. Lynda Gilbert.

Also discussed were the parking options, on inclement weather days, for individuals that bike to and from work. Dr. Cook asked if these options could be sent to him in a memo after the meeting.

The committee will not meet in December due to the holiday schedule. Transportation Services will relocate to their new office in the Campus Drive parking deck in December, and the January committee meeting will be held in their conference room. Members will be notified when the date and time have been determined.

Since there was no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
